REGULATIONS OVER THE ADMISSION OF PETS IN THE CAMPSITE



Your pets are welcome here at Camping Laguna Village! To avoid disturbing the other guests, we kindly ask you to read and respect the following rules:

- 1- The presence of pets and their quantity must be reported at the time of booking and upon arrival. Pets are admitted only to certain designated camping pitches called *Piazzole Perlina* and accommodations called *Maxi Caravan Stellina* and *Maxi Caravan Stellina Deluxe*. A maximum of 2 pets are permitted per pitch/accommodation.
- **2-** Small and medium-sized pets, of non-dangerous breeds or considered as such by the competent authorities are allowed. When checking in, pets must have their health records with them, showing all vaccinations envisaged by the Italian law have been carried out.
- **3-** Dogs may not be left unattended in the camping pitches or accommodations. Dogs must always be kept on a lead, measuring a maximum of 1.5 m in length (Italian Ministry Order 03.03.2009) and owners must have a suitable sized muzzle with them to be used when necessary or upon request by the competent authorities.
- **4-** The access of pets into the swimming pools, common toilets and inside the supermarket is forbidden.
- 5- Dogs are allowed to access the free beach if they are kept on a leash but they are not allowed to enter the water, with the exception of the specifically allocated and authorised areas (beach resort "Bau beach", located 500 m from the campsite).
- 6- The owner is responsible for guaranteeing the maximum respect for hygiene and sanitary regulations and standards. While staying on the campsite, pets must always be accompanied to the designated area for their toilet requirements and owners must remove the droppings immediately after using a special bag and the containers provided.
- **7-** Any damage caused by pets to others or to the campsite facilities lies under the full responsibility of its owner.
- **8-** Any cruelty to pets will be reported to the relevant authorities.

The management reserves the right to remove guests who do not observe these regulations and those in which the pet is particularly noisy or dangerous.
